Meeting was opened with the Lords Prayer by President Bill Pribula.

The Secretary's and Treasurer's report were reviewed. Clarification from last treasurers report regarding the \$638 designated to Ronald McDonald House. Per Grace, this was for checks written to the church designated to the Ronald McDonald House. Motion made by Kris Lien to approve minutes and treasurer's report, seconded by Jill Wohler. Motion carried.

Committee Business

- Worship (Deb & Jill) nothing new will plan return to normal offering of passing plate during an offering hymn this fall.
- Stewardship (DeNae & Jason) nothing to report.
- Education (Randy & Alisha) Vacation bible school went well and was well attended.
- Properties/Grounds & Parsonage (Bill & Nate)
- Altar Windows still waiting on Northern Glass from Fargo to come down and take a look to give us an estimate. Nate also is reaching out to another person who may do windows like this and will see if he can come down and give an estimate.
- Exterior wood around the stained-glass windows. Received rough estimate from Christopher Ferderer for \$7400. He is unsure of material cost as he is waiting on a subcontractor that would do the shaping of the frame. Due to the complexity of fixing these windows and the fact that we have been unable to get other contractors willing to bid, counsel is in favor of moving ahead with this. Plan will be a congregational vote July 9th. Bill will announce special meeting at the next 2 weeks church service.
- Landscape cement timbers for flower beds project is complete
 - Church floor tile nothing to update
- Sinking Air Conditioner unit update.
 Crossroads did come and straighten this.
- Light switch in fellowship Storage room fixed per Crossroads.

- o **Gutters and downspout damage** updates Estimate for fixing and replacing \$1500 Jill Baldwin made a motion to proceed with this and Kris Lien seconded, motion carried.
- Humidity issue in basement Discussed some further options for more efficient way of dealing with the humidity. Jason and Bill are looking at a couple of different options. They will get more info and cost estimates.

Deb will reach out and let Grace know this.
