- Worship & Shepherding (Kelly, Lonnie)
 - Rick reported that the goal is for the children's sermon to be done each Sunday that there is Sunday School, but it is still a work in progress.
- Stewardship (Diane, Andrea)
 - Sargent County Fair Board has offered an opportunity for MLC to have a pancake feed and cowboy service at the Sargent County Fair; stewardship committee will discuss further.
- Education (Randy, Alisha)
 - Confirmation is working on community service during lent with sponsoring supper.
- Properties/Grounds/Parsonage (Myron, Travers, Don)
 - Shed for parsonage was discussed.
 - Wall under Satre Lounge-G&M will go look at the wall & make a decision.
 - Lighting in church; Don talked to Crossroad's about this and the lighting on the cross & they are going to give us some options .
 - Dog Poop – there have been a couple of complaints about this in the parking lot, Don has talked to Terry Dusek and he said the city can't do anything unless we know who the dogs and owners are (which we do not know at this time). The council cannot do anything regarding this issue.
 - Since we have the new hot water heater, it may need to be adjusted to be hotter, G&M will take a look.

- Enrolled in 2 classes right now & it's going well.
- Rick also reported on items in the committee business above.

- Cross Lighting – Crossroads is going to get back to us, we'd want to go with LED lights but will need to have a quote.

 - Education – Randy Syrstad & Alisha Olson
 - Grounds & Maintenance – Myron Yagow, Don Nelson, & Travers Storhaug
- Appointment of Vice President, Myron Yagow nominated, Motion to approve from Randy, Travers seconded, all in favor.
- Sound System – Randy will talk to Booster Club to see if we can get any funding for a new sound system.
- Answers to the annual meeting questions:
 - Miscellaneous income of \$30,303? – This was donations consisting of the parsonage flooring, windows for church, specials, sale of LP tank, sale of water heater, cash calendar, & donation from Sakry Plumbing.
 - How much left in Special Assessments? – Should be between \$4-5k left, will know the amount after the county processes the payment.
 - How much spent in 2019 on parsonage? – Nearly \$15,000, of that around \$8,500 for flooring, \$1,000 for blinds, the rest was miscellaneous expenses like plumbing, cleaning, electrical, mowing, etc.
- March 30th Mobile Food Pantry and next on June 3rd
 - Diane suggested getting the word out to donate extra garden produce; it was suggested that this could be put in the summer and fall newsletters.
- Sunrise service attendance has been decreasing each year; 2019 - 30; 2018 – 45. Council decided to continue this year with sunrise, but determined if this year is low in attendance as previous years, will revisit.
- Randy will tend to the snow removal in front of the doors & get help as needed.
- New membership for Jeanne McCauley approved by council.

Next Meeting: Next meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, March 10th, 2020 @ 7 pm (there is a conflict for March 11th). Motion to adjourn by Diane, Kelly seconded, all in favor.


