Secretary's minutes & Treasurer's Reports were reviewed, motion made to approve minutes as recorded by Jill Baldwin, seconded by Randy Syrstad. Motion carried.

Welcome to the new council members: Nate Sundquist, Jill Baldwin & Kris Lien. Election of officers completed with all voting to retain current officers for another year. President: Bill Pribula, Vice President: Randy Syrstad & Secretary: Deb Wagner. New Members that were present were assigned to committees as follows: Jill Baldwin –worship committee and Nate – Properties & Grounds. Jason will move to the Stewardship committee, and we will assign Kris at next meeting.

### **Committee Business**

- Worship Continued discussion regarding restarting acolytes on Sundays. Council would like to see this reimplemented but do not feel that the wearing of robes is needed. Pastor Rick will bring this up at next confirmation. As stated in previous minutes, noisy offering will be gathered on April 16th. There will also be special music by Bryce Hogness on Palm Sunday.
- Stewardship Nothing new to report. DeNae will get committee together to start looking at focuses for this year.
- Education Nothing new with Sunday School, great to see so many children each Sunday. Discussed requiring bible camp for confirmation. This was required in the past and council feels this is a great opportunity for students to share and grow in their faith.
