The meeting was opened with a prayer from Pastor Rick

The Secretary and Treasurer's reports were reviewed. Motion made to approve as recorded by Kris Lien and seconded by Jill Baldwin. All in favor, Motion carried.

#### **Committee Business**

- Worship (Deb & Jill) Online giving going to ask for info to be on bulletin every week – We have had a request to have ushers to usher people out again.
- Stewardship (DeNae & Jason)—Fall rummage sale proceeds will be going to the special Olympics. We will be looking at having a gift tree around Christmas. Will have more details on that as we get closer.


