September 19th, 2024

The council met on Thursday, September 19th at Immanuel Lutheran Church. Council Members present were Tanner Martinson, Kevin Moxness, Derek Martinson, and Mindy Hogness. Tanner called the meeting to order. Pastor Rick gave a devotion. The Secretary's Report was read and a motion to approve was made by Kevin, seconded by Derek. The Treasurer's Report was read and a motion to approve was made by Mindy, seconded by Kevin. Pastor Rick gave a Pastor's Report stating that he's registered for a college course, has been busy with hospital visits and supporting Wendy's onboarding to her new role. He remarked that Sunday School is a delight and a blessing to have at Immanuel. Confirmation at Milnor Luther Church will be beginning soon. He recognized five years of service in the Pastor role and commented that he has just as much vigor as he did in year one.

Committees:

Old Business:

- Property Repair List:
 - Gravel out front, seeding grass, and water leaking to the basement were all addressed and removed from the agenda. Cement cracks/unlevel on the south side of the church will be tabled until next year.
 - Plaster repair behind the pulpit James Martinson
 - 9/19 Update: Revisit this project post-Harvest the council discussed that sheetrock and insulation will be needed.
 - Cement under the shed James Martinson
 - 9/19 Update: James leveled it off; we'll see if more is needed this fall.
 - o Lights need to be addressed in the sanctuary to improve brightness.

New Business:

- Property Repair List:
 - Windows: The council discussed replacing some of the storm windows and agreed to ask someone to evaluate this project after the plaster project is complete.
 - o Siding: The council discussed concerns on the siding, notably near the bell tower.
 - Shingles: The council discussed the condition of the shingles and options to replace.

A motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Kevin, seconded by Derek. We closed with the Lord's Prayer. The next meeting will take place on Wednesday, November 20th at 6pm.
