

The Secretary's and Treasurer's reports were reviewed. No corrections or additions. Wade Kuehne made a motion to approve the reports and seconded by Paula Tayer; all in favor, motion carried.

Committee Business

• Worship (Jill) – Discussed Easter Service(s): It was decided to do 2 services as we did last year, 6:30am & 10am Easter Service. Will follow-up with Rick to make sure that this will work with Immanuel's schedule.

• Stewardship (Loren & Paula) Endowment fund – Paula spoke with Mitch Tompkins. We currently have some funds that we can dispense. Paula and Grace will be looking through the documentation and working on getting the committee set up.

• Education (Jennifer) – Jennifer spoke with Red Willow Bible camp. VBS is scheduled for June 15th

• Properties/Grounds & Parsonage (Kris, Nate & Wade) Exterior wood on bottom of the stained-glass windows. Tabled.

• External Church Sign – door won't close – Tabled.

• Parsonage projects • Update on doors and windows in the breezeway and the egress window in basement. Doors and windows have been ordered.

• • Window Well covers – included with the doors and window orders.

• • Old well room mold. The contractor has been down to evaluate, and work will start when he is available.

• • Outside Outlets – Tabled. Will be fixed with well room/patio repair.

• Carpet cleaning Church and fellowship hall – This has been completed.

New Business

• Church Insurance – Paula reports that insurance went up \$3500 this year. Overall insurance has gone up and there are not a lot of options. After reviewing possible options, Kris Lien made a motion to continue with the current insurance, Wade Kuehn seconded; all in favor, motion carried.

• Electrical outlets back by the organ – With additional equipment back there we now have extension cords plugged into extension cords which is a fire safety issue. Kris will talk with Crossroads to add some additional outlets.

• Broken Window – fellowship hall – Nate is looking into replacement as it doesn't look like we can just fix the upper window only.

• Sink in the Sacristy- filter needs cleaning or replacement – Kris will take care of this.

• We had a request to be a sponsoring organization for Don Marquette's Operation Round Up application to Dakota Valley. There is no direct cost involved. Jill will take care of the application.

• There was a congregational request to resume children's sermons. Jill will talk with Rick about starting that again.
