**The Secretary's and Treasurer's** reports were reviewed. No corrections or additions. Nate Sundquist made a motion to approve the reports and seconded by Paula Tayer; all in favor, motion carried.

#### **Committee Business**

- Worship (Jill)—Lou Diede, Linda Costain and Jean Anderson have volunteered to join the worship committee. We will be meeting next
  Sunday after church. We have a total of 5 volunteers willing to help with organ music on Sundays. Deb is working on getting a
  rotation schedule put in place.
- Stewardship (Loren & Paula) Discussed some possible options, nothing decided at this time.
- Education (Jason)—The Sunday School Program will be on December 8th.
- Properties/Grounds & Parsonage (Kris, Nate& Wade)
  - Exterior wood on bottom of the stained-glass windows. Nothing to update currently.
  - External Church Sign door issue. This will be tabled for now.
  - Parsonage projects
    - Basement Window replacement Nate reports that Riverside Building Center should be coming this week for estimate.
    - Window Well covers This will be included with the Riverside Estimate.
    - Old well room mold, front door screen door and breezeway doors and window replacement—Nate will be ordering supplies. Once they come in, will reach out to the contractor for installation.
    - Outside Outlets Tabled. Will be fixed with well room/patio repair.
  - o Carpet cleaning Church and fellowship hall waiting on an estimate.
  - Water bill review parsonage. Cost was back to normal this month. Nothing further needed.
  - o The furnace in the parsonage is having issues. This is currently being worked on.
  - o It was discovered that there is mold in the basement of the church in almost every room. The mold seems to be coming through the paint. The committee will look after the meeting and determine the next steps.

Pastor's Report – Rick reports that he has completed another class for the Team Program. We have had many funerals in the past few weeks, and we have a couple more coming up.

This Sunday is Synod Endowment Day – the synod is asking for each church to make an extra donation this year to help with some additional causes. Refer to new business for decision.

### **Old Business**

- Update on lay ministry workshops (Jill) We had a New Testament workshop here at MLC a couple of weekends ago and lunch was served. There were 16 that attended.
- Projecting of services—Loren and Rick met with a company regarding replacement of the current audio system as well as possibility of
  adding Video in the front of the church for projecting services. The estimate was reviewed, and all council members were in favor of
  moving forward with this. Projecting would require some additional licenses, and installation would include instructions and support.
   Jill will plan to announce a congregational meeting the next 2 Sundays with a vote on December 4.
- Office Printer Replacement: The Booster Club gave a donation to cover the cost of replacement. Grace is coordinating with the printer company to get this installed.

#### **New Business**

- Pastors Contract is due in December. A motion was made by Loren Ellefson to increase his salary by \$1000 next year, seconded by Jill Baldwin; all in favor, motion carried.
- A motion made by Kris Lien to have the offering from this Sunday be donated to the Synod Endowment Day to go to the Campus Ministry Fund. Paula Tayer seconded the motion; all in favor, motion carried.
- The council sent a donation from our congregation to plant a memorial tree in memory of Pastor Vold.
- Grace reported that there is a CD coming due. The council voted to renew the CD at the current rate.
- The proposed budget was reviewed. Jill will send back the discussion to Grace and will review again in the December meeting.

Paula Tayer made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Jill Baldwin seconded; all in favor, motion carried.

Tanner called the meeting to order. The Secretary's Report was read and a motion to approve was made by Derek, seconded by Kevin. The Treasurer's Report was read and a motion to approve was made by Kevin, seconded by Paul.

#### **Committees:**

- **Education:** Sunday School is wrapping up their Fall lessons and moving to the Winter lessons, while also preparing for the upcoming Sunday School Christmas Program which will be held on Sunday, December 15<sup>th</sup>.Practices outside of regular Sunday School time will be on Wednesday December 11<sup>th</sup> at 5:30pm and Saturday December 14<sup>th</sup> at 9am. Note, there will be no Sunday School on December 1st.
- Property & Maintenance: Property & Maintenance items were discussed in Old Business.

#### **Old Business:**

- Property:
  - Plaster repair behind the pulpit
    - 11/6 Update: James will pick up supplies with Tanner's trailer.
  - o Cement under the shed
    - 11/6 Update: We'll check if more dirt is needed in the spring.
  - Lights, Windows, Siding & Shingles will all be re-evaluated after aligning with the congregation at the annual meeting on actions taken based on the letter that we received from our insurance company regarding the roof and siding.

#### **New Business:**

- Property:
  - o Insurance Letter: We received a letter from the insurance company that we must address the shingles and spire otherwise our premium will increase, though it sounds like the premium will increase regardless as the repairs will increase the value. Derek will investigate the policy breakdown and find out our options for reduction. The council is unsure what contractor can support the spire project; Tanner will ask Dusty his opinion. Additional conversation on next steps will be discussed at our Annual Meeting with the congregation.

A motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Mindy, seconded by Kevin. We closed with the Lord's Prayer. The next meeting will take place on Wednesday, January 15<sup>th</sup> at 6pm.
