Secretary & Treasurer's Report: Read & reviewed reports. Discussion was held regarding the rental contract for the church & fellowship hall, specifically focusing on the clause about cleaning after events. The council decided to include wording that either requires renters to clean up after themselves and leave the space in acceptable condition or request cleaning services and to make sure that Barb is informed about what the renters have agreed to.
